ORDER

On August 21, 2012, pursuant to Rule 3.04 the *Rules of Practice and Procedure* ("RPPs") of the Arkansas Public Service Commission ("Commission"), the Arkansas Advanced Energy Association ("AAEA") submitted a Petition to Intervene ("Petition") in this docket. In the Petition, AAEA stated that it is a trade association of advanced energy companies in Arkansas, including companies that manufacture or utilize renewable energy components and educators, researchers, consultants and public officials who are focused on the development of advanced energy in Arkansas. Petition at ¶ 3. AAEA states that it has an interest in being heard regarding meter aggregation rules because they have the potential to promote growth and development of renewable energy, and that its interest will not be adequately represented by other parties. *Id.* at ¶ 5.

On August 23, 2012, the General Staff ("Staff") of the Arkansas Public Service Commission ("Commission") submitted a Response to AAEA's Petition. In that Response, Staff stated that it does not object to AAEA's Petition, provided that AAEA identifies its members for the purposes of this proceeding. On August 24, 2012, AAEA submitted its membership list.

On the bases that AAEA has an interest in this proceeding which will not be adequately represented by any other party, that Staff does not object, and that AAEA has submitted its membership list, the Commission approves AAEA's Petition.
